

Pre-care instructions

If you are planning either to have an eyeliner procedure and are a contact lens user, please wear or bring your lenses/eye glasses to all appointments.

- Do not wear contact lenses during any procedure involving your eye(s).
- It is recommended to have a driver available or "on-call" to drive you home following a procedure involving your eye(s).
- Do not schedule an appointment prior to major events, such as a vacation, wedding, social outing, etc. as you will have to wear an aftercare ointment on your procedure site(s) for one week following the procedure(s).
- If you are planning a lip color procedure and have ever experienced a cold sore, even one time in your life, it is recommended you obtain a prescribed anti-viral medication. The medication must be taken two days prior to the procedure.
- If you have had any type of lips surgery, consult with the physician about how long you should wait before having a permanent makeup procedure on the lips. Most physicians are giving a 3 week ok after lip filler injections like collagen or Restylane. If the lip surgery involves an incision (like a lip implant), the incision needs to mature about 6 months before tattooing on top of it.
- If you are required to take antibiotic medication prior to seeing your dentist, you will need to take antibiotic medication prior to having your procedure done.
- It is necessary to be off of Accutane for one year, prior to all procedures. It is necessary to be off Retin A or Renova for 30 days, prior to a procedure.
- Try to avoid aspirin and non-aspirin products for 7 days prior to all procedures unless medically necessary.
- Try to avoid Vitamin E and Niacin for two weeks prior to all procedures unless medically necessary. Please note that all Multi-vitamins contain Vitamin-E.
- Avoid alcohol the night before all procedures.
- All professional tweezing, waxing or tinting of eyebrow hairs should be done know more than 72 hours prior to a procedure. Please avoid any depilatory or bleaching agents on your lips pre and post lip tattooing. All lash perms and lashing tinting can be done up to 72 hours pre procedure and 30 days post procedure. If you wear fake eye lashes you cannot wear them pre, during or post procedure
